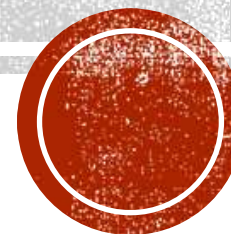


SOME AND ANY

- Estas dos palabras son determinantes. Quiere decir que nos ayudan a determinar la cantidad o la parte de algo a lo que nos referimos. Estas dos palabras no tienen una traducción directa, pero podríamos traducirlas como 'algo de', 'algún', 'alguno', 'alguna', 'algunos', 'algunas'.



SUSTANTIVOS CONTABLES E INCONTABLES

- Countable nouns are thing that we can count

I have a brother

There are two glasses on the table

There are fourteen students in the class

- Countable nouns have a singular and plural form. We can use a/an with the singular form

Do you want a banana? - I like bananas

We need an egg for this recipe – We need three eggs for this recipe



- Uncountable nouns are things that we can't count. They usually don't have a plural form, and we can't use a /an with them

I don't like cheese

Do you like lemonade?

We are having pasta for dinner



SOME AND ANY

- We use some in affirmative statements with uncountable nouns and plural countable nouns.

There is some milk in the fridge

There are some apples in the bowl

- We use any in negative statements and questions with uncountable nouns and plural countable nouns

There is not any milk

We don't have any oranges

Do you have any money

Are there any strawberries
