

PAST SIMPLE

NEGATIVE FORM

- Para construir oraciones en pasado simple en su forma negativa se tiene que utilizar el auxiliar *do/does*, el cual es el único que se conjuga en pasado. El verbo principal permanece en su forma infinitiva. Por ejemplo:
 - ✓ Afirmativa: *I went to your house on my bicycle.*
 - ✓ Negativa: *I didn't go to your house on my bicycle.*
 - ✓ Afirmativa: *They practiced their play all weekend.*
 - ✓ Negativa: *They didn't practice their play all weekend.*

QUESTION FORM

- En cuanto a las oraciones interrogativas, nuevamente hay que usar el auxiliar *do/does*. Al igual que en la forma negativa, solo el auxiliar se conjuga en pasado, mientras el verbo principal se queda en su forma infinitiva.
- ✓ Afirmativa: *You remembered the correct answer just before the end of test time.*
- ✓ Interrogativa: *Did you remember the correct answer just before the end of test time.*
- ✓ Afirmativa: *Your dog destroyed my new shoes in five minutes.*
- ✓ Interrogativa: *Did your dog destroy my new shoes in five minutes?*

Singular	Plural
<i>I did not (didn't) go</i> <i>You did not (didn't) go</i> <i>He/she/It did not (didn't) go</i>	<i>We didn't go</i> <i>You didn't go</i> <i>They didn't go</i>

- ***I didn't go** to school on Monday.*
- *Stefany **didn't like** the meal.*
- *He **didn't talk** to me yesterday.*

Singular	Plural
<i>Did I go?</i> <i>Did you go?</i> <i>Did he/she/it go?</i>	<i>Did we go?</i> <i>Did you go?</i> <i>Did they go?</i>

- ***Did you go** to the supermarket? – No, I **didn't**.*
- ***Did he play** football? – Yes, he **did**.*
- ***Did they watch** a film? – No, they **didn't**.*
