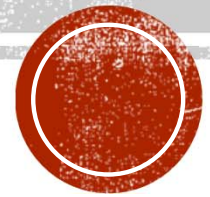


PHRASAL VERBS



¿WHAT IS A PHRASAL VERB?

A **phrasal verb** is a **verb** that is made up of a main **verb** together with an adverb or a preposition, or both.

Typically, their meaning is not obvious from the meanings of the individual words themselves.

For **example**: She has always **looked down** on me.

PRASAL VERBS WITH UP

- I want to GIVE UP drinking, but I can't
- WAKE me UP at 6 and lets go to run
- HURRY UP or you will miss the bus.
- I glad you're coming, I PICK you UP at the airport!
- Hey guys, STAND UP when the teacher enters.
- TIDY UP your room right now.

- PUT ON his coat this baby, its really cold.
- TURN ON the TV, something important is happening.
- TRY ON this dress, I´m sure you will like it.
- If I don´t come back tomorrow, CARRY ON

- WATCH OUT! This is dangerous!.
- PUT OUT this fire, we are close to the forest.
- Would you like to GO OUT with me?
