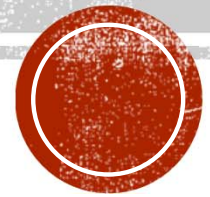

Soy profesor **y vivo en Colombia**



I am sick **but I have to work**
Estoy enfermo **pero tengo que trabajar**





Will you pay with money or credit card ?

Conjunciones Subordinantes

after	unless
as	until
because	when
before	while
since	



You can have as much as you wish
puedes tener tanto como deseés

They are working as we speak
ellos están trabajando mientras
hablamos





I wanna taste the ice cream **before I can buy it**
Quiero probar el helado **antes de poder**
comprarlo





I have lived here **since 1994**
Yo he vivido acá **desde 1994**

I never understood English **until I met Alejo**

Yo nunca entendí Inglés **hasta que conocí a Alejo**



we were eating **when you called me**
nosotros estábamos comiendo **cuando** me llamaste



I just want to live my life **while I'm
still young**

Yo solo quiero vivir mi vida **mientras
aún estoy jóven**





Difference Between **DURING**, **FOR**, **WHILE**

DURING

To state when something happens

During + Noun

Examples;

- We listened to the teacher **during** the French lesson.
- I sleep **during** lunch.
- She played beach volleyball every day **during** her vacation.
- We visited London **during** our holiday in England.

FOR

To state how long something happens

For + length of time

Examples;

- I will love you **for** ever.
- They put her in prison **for** life.
- You have been smoking **for** a year.
- I hadn't seen Chicago **for** a long time.
- He is going to sleep **for** two hours.

WHILE

To talk about two things that are happening at the same time

While + Subject + Verb

Examples;

- **While** I was watching TV, door rang.
- **While** I was analyzing the data, two errors occurred.
- Please sit down **while** I tell you something.
